LONESTARP3 is a statewide network that brings multiple perspectives together-inviting researchers, practitioners, and policy advocates to work together. Our partners design, generate, and translate research into accessible and actionable solutions. Our collaborative approach produces research with clear and immediate use in both classroom teaching and policymaking.

#### LONESTARP3 Research Collaboratives

Research Collaboratives will include a minimum of two RP3 Members to work collectively to investigate the research questions from our shared Pathways Research Agenda.


Collaborative members will be selected based on their:

- access to the target population and demographics
- expertise on the topic and necessary research methods
- their capacity to **complete agile investigations** that surface meaningful insights in 12-18 months.

# Why the P-20W Data System Matters

#### Shared **bright spots**

- Long-standing and robust longitudinal data system
- Resources for new researchers emerging over time
- More public-facing tools being developed (e.g., E3 Alliance Education Profile)





# Why the P-20W Data System Matters

#### Shared **challenges**

- Availability: Public access + additional user-friendly tools.
- Accessibility: Documentation, awareness of data, and business rules
- Stakeholder engagement: Focus, feasibility, and space for collaboration.





# Introducing the LONESTARP3 Data Council

- Mission: Strengthen the P-20W data system to inspire action and improve outcomes.
- Purpose: Create a collaborative space to identify bright spots and challenges and inspire solutions.



#### Goals of the Data Council

- Empower Stakeholders: Use data to inform decisions and inspire action.
- **Highlight Bright Spots and Challenges**: Showcase effective practices and address data limitations.
- Annual Report: Publish a "State of the State" report to spotlight trends and priorities.
- Foster Collaboration: Create a community of practice for data-driven solutions.

# Key Activities

- Data Dialogues Convenings:
  - One in-person gathering each year
- Virtual Community of Practice Meetings:
  - System Bright Spots and Pain Points
  - Member Perspectives and Solutions
  - Data Access and Transparency
- Briefs and Annual Report:
  - Publish Council Briefs each quarter to recap key topics.
  - Publish an annual "State of the State" report to spotlight statewide data trends and emerging priorities.
