

Potential Topics for Research Frameworks

TEXAS TEACHER WORKFORCE

Recruitment, preparation, certification, placement, and retention

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Access, quality, funding, and workforce of programs serving children from birth through age five

OUT OF SCHOOL LEARNING

Opportunities that take place outside the school day, including afterschool programs, summer learning, and extended day

NON-ACADEMIC STUDENT SUPPORTS

Strategies that address barriers to learning and promote student well-being, such as efforts to reduce absenteeism, food- and housing-insecurity, or mental health challenges

SCHOOL TURNAROUND REFORM

Strategies to improve chronically underperforming schools through targeted interventions and community engagement

SCHOOL FINANCE

Policies, formulas, and funding mechanisms that determine how public education is financed

RURAL EDUCATION

Strengths and challenges faced by Texas schools in geographically isolated communities, including limited access to resources, staffing, and advanced coursework



Application of Research Frameworks

- Surface priority areas of work across RP3 Members to facilitate knowledge sharing and internal collaboration
- Identify light-touch, low-cost efforts to produce products that represent findings and recommendations from across
 Members on select topics
- Establish a set of organizing frameworks that will create strong positioning for allocating internal resources or pursuing external funding to support collaborative research
