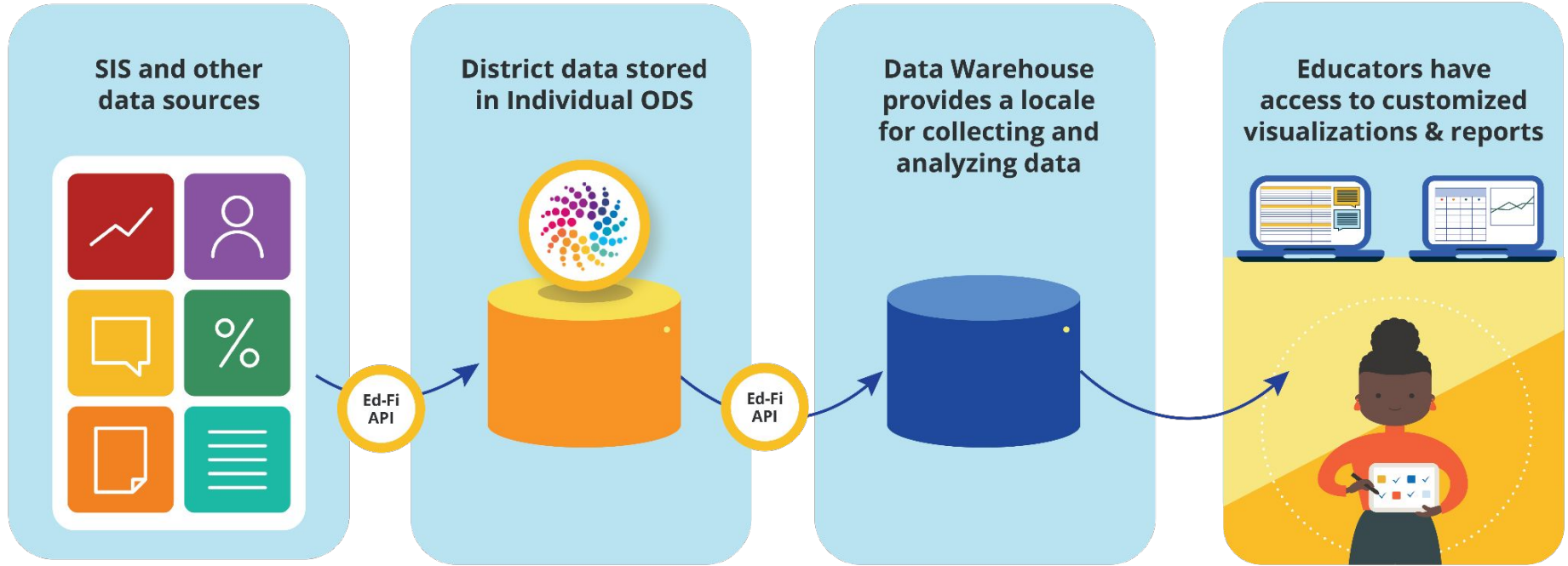


The Exchange leverages the Ed-Fi Data Standard



- Ed-Fi is a **data standard**, a set of rules that establishes a **unified structure** for educational data. It **seamlessly connects** data from different systems.
- The Exchange is working toward expanding that **common language across Texas** to include TSDS/PEIMS codes plus additional codes where they are needed. This will enable all “downstream” partners (e.g., vendors, districts and charter schools, regions, researchers) to work from a common language.
- Ed-Fi is **free** and **open source**.
- Ed-Fi also provides a **support community** with documentation and support forums so **users can share solutions**.

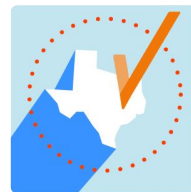

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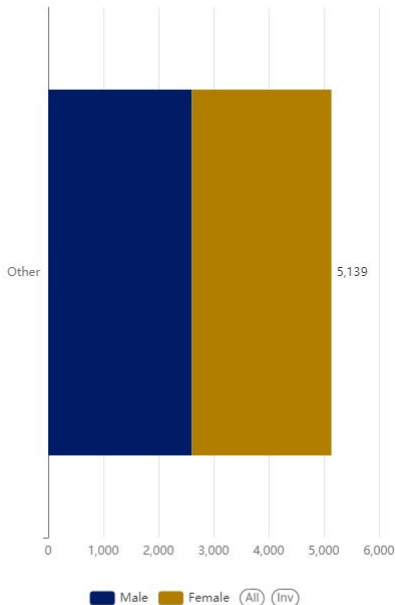

Enrollment by Grade Level and Gender

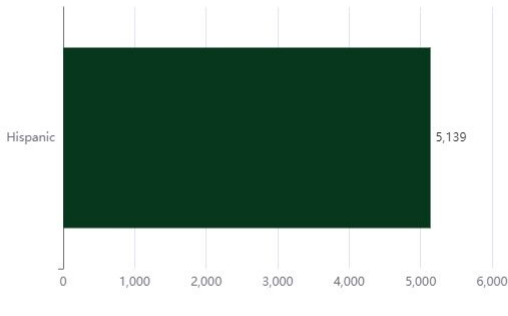


Percentage of Students with at least one Non-Passing Grade on Transcript

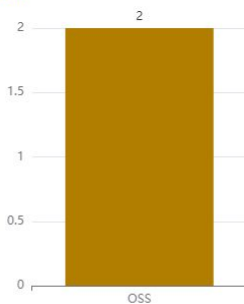


Number of Students by Attendance Rate Group

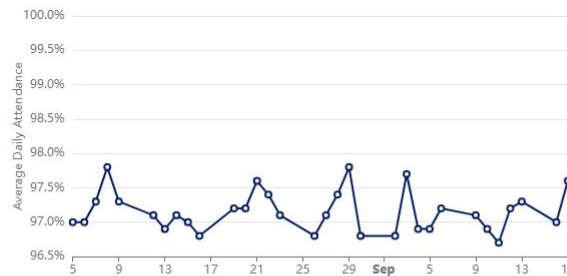

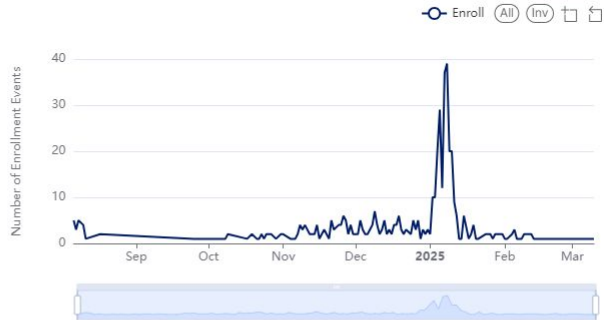

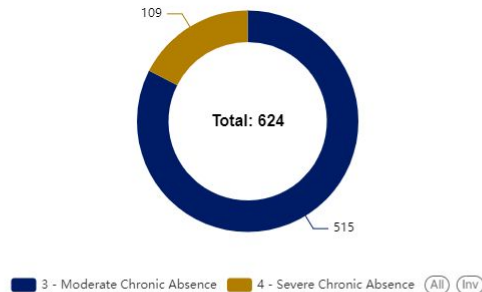

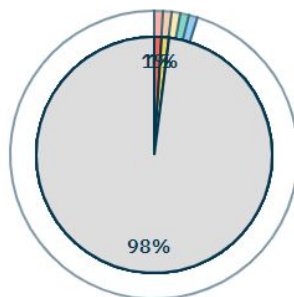
