




Intention





Data Council



LONESTARP3 Data Council

Mission

Increase visibility and use of Texas P20W data system, resources, and published research. Provide insights and recommendations to inform improvements to Texas data systems and tools to enhance their impact on education practice and policy.

Purpose

Address educational challenges through data-driven insights, and create shared, actionable knowledge to benefit Texas students, educators, and policymakers.



Data Council Goals

Highlight Bright Spots and Challenges: Showcase effective practices and address data limitations, particularly in the Texas P20W data system.

Empower Stakeholders: Use statewide data systems to inform decisions and inspire action in both practice and policy.

Foster Collaboration: Create a community of practice that generates and shared tools, resources and findings to aid and accelerate data-driven solutions.

Annual Report: Publish a "State of the State" report to spotlight trends and resources generated by Texas statewide data systems.



DATA COUNCIL EARLY ACTIVITIES

January 2025: Launch & Visioning

Convened the first Data Council meeting

Collected feedback on **usability**, **audiences**, **and next steps**

Emerging Product: Texas Regional Pathways Crosswalk

The Challenge: Data systems are siloed across state education and workforce agencies and there is no comprehensive linkage framework.

What it is: A publicly available crosswalk connecting IBCs, CTE programs of study, college fields of study, occupations, and regional wage and demand data.

What it enables: Helps researchers and policymakers evaluate and improve the alignment of student pathways across systems, enables districts to design programs that align with regional labor market demand and postsecondary credentials, and supports advisors and families in making informed choices about programs and careers.

Emerging Product: CCMR Platform Landscape & Roadmap

The Challenge: Districts face a fragmented landscape of CCMR readiness tools. These tools use inconsistent indicators, measures, and data definitions. This makes it difficult to track student readiness accurately and consistently.

What it is: A landscape scan of existing CCMR tools, summarizing their features, strengths, and weaknesses, and outlining a roadmap for developing a shared, open-source platform to address gaps.

What it enables: Helps districts and regional service centers compare and evaluate existing tools, identify gaps and pain points, and plan toward a coordinated CCMR tracking system that supports consistent and accurate decision-making.



What's Next for Data Council

Build on our momentum by:

- Refine initial products and plan for dissemination
- Explore formats for making products more accessible
- Identify additional high-priority topics for future products
- Expand outreach to new audiences (district leaders, agency staff, workforce partners)

Goal: Grow the Data Council into a hub for insights, tools, research, and collaboration that strengthen the use and impact of the Texas P20W data system.
