Q1 2025: Launch Statewide Data Council

24-member council launched to improve Texas' education data systems, tools, and resources.

Q3 2025: Host Virtual Sessions and Livestreams

Averaging 120+ registrants for online events!

Q4 2025: Launch Strategy Teams

Invited small teams to help inform future research efforts in Teacher Workforce, Public Education Finance, and Early Childhood Education.

Q4 2025: Release Data Council Products

A comprehensive CCMR crosswalk and an open source CCMR tool.

Initiate Co-Chairs, Exec Committee and expanded membership on Steering Committee

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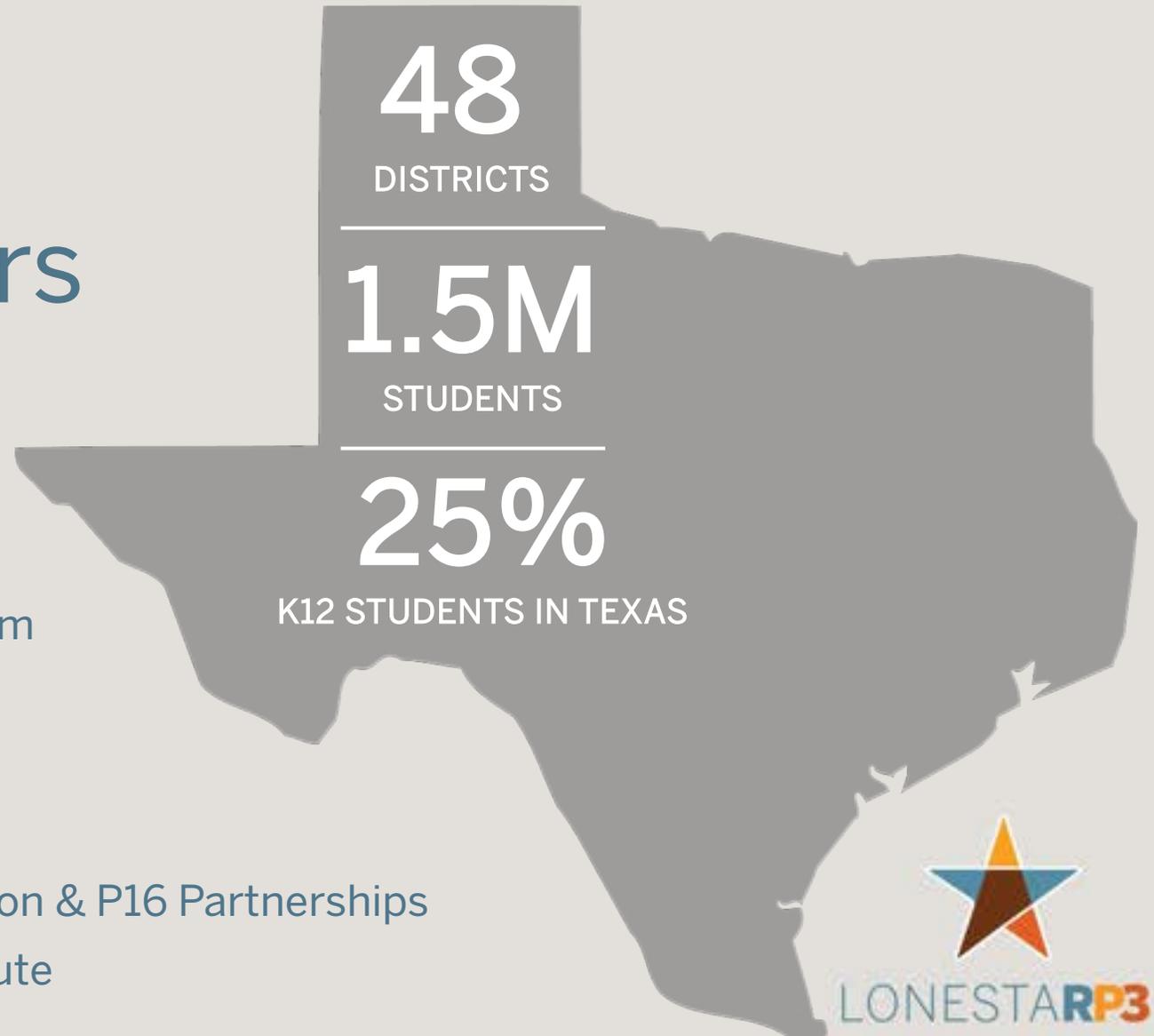

LONESTAR^{RP3} Governance Principles

1

Relationship of Membership to Governance

RP3 **draws from its membership** to operate a **shared Governance model** that serves to inform the direction, operations, and health of the Network.

2

Purpose of Governance

RP3 governance provides an **open and transparent forum** for **Network leaders** to surface concerns, assess needs, and generate solutions to support Network operations and impact.

3

Representation of Voices

RP3 governance structures are **inclusive of diverse perspectives** - including research, practice, and policy - from **within its members and beyond**.

4

Structure of Governance

RP3 maintains a **lean governance model** with a set of **interconnected structures** that preserve **Core Members** (RPPs and Collective Impact organizations) as the **majority voice** in decision-making.

LONESTAR^{RP3} Membership Principles

1

Clarity and Accountability

RP3 seeks to shift from a startup enterprise to sustainable entity. Our membership model articulates clear commitments and reciprocal benefits to ensure founding members are **accountable to one another** and to set **expectations for those who join** our Network in the future.

2

Intentional Representation

RP3 seeks to be a statewide network, **representative of the diverse institutions, geographies and communities of Texas**. Our membership model defines a default structure to ensure we fulfill that promise and leverage that representation to increase our impact.

3

Influence Aligned to Commitments

RP3 seeks to create impact by working with and through a **strategic set of practice, policy, and data partners** who share our vision. Our membership model ensures these partners are integrated into our community to both shape and implement our shared work.

4

Access and Connection

RP3 seeks to be a reliable source of research and a trusted broker to leaders and actors across the state. Our membership model provides an affiliation—a **sense of belonging—for organizations that will grow our reputation and reach**, and serve as a **conduit for future members**.

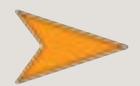


LONESTAR**P3** Approach

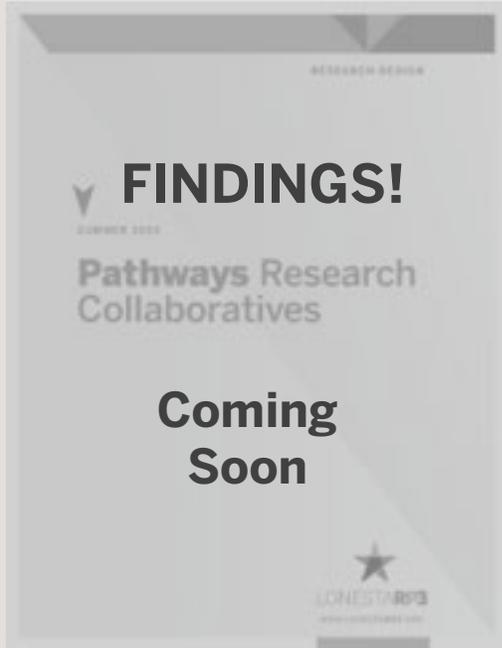
