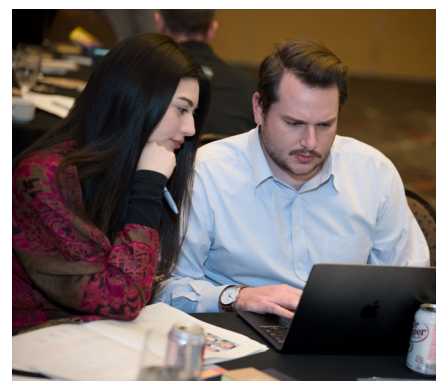
A STATEWIDE NETWORK

All across Texas, students face a wide range of educational challenges that pose real barriers to their success. While research offers promising solutions, findings rarely reach the educators, policymakers, and families who need them most.

Texas cannot afford to wait. The scale, complexity, and urgency of today's challenges demand a different model—one that accelerates the path from evidence to action and connects rigorous research directly to the people and systems responsible for improving lives. Our collaborative research-to-action model means our findings are disseminated more quickly and immediately relevant to decision-makers.

By bringing together researchers, educators, and policy advocates at the outset, LONESTAR^{RP3} transforms evidence into practical solutions that more quickly reach schools, expand opportunities, and improve outcomes for students and communities across Texas.



DISCOVERING SOLUTIONS

Collaborative Research

LONESTARP3 is turning shared priorities into collective action through collaborative research.

➤ 01. Convene

We bring diverse perspectives together to align on priorities and build consensus early. Our members represent all sectors, keeping investigations focused on the most relevant questions.

➤ 02. Investigate

We mobilize a statewide research network and leverage Texas data systems to generate timely, actionable findings—shortening the path from study design to results.

➤ 03. Activate

We turn research into tools, products, and experiences that benefit students. By working closely with practice and advocacy partners from the start, we accelerate the journey from findings to solutions.

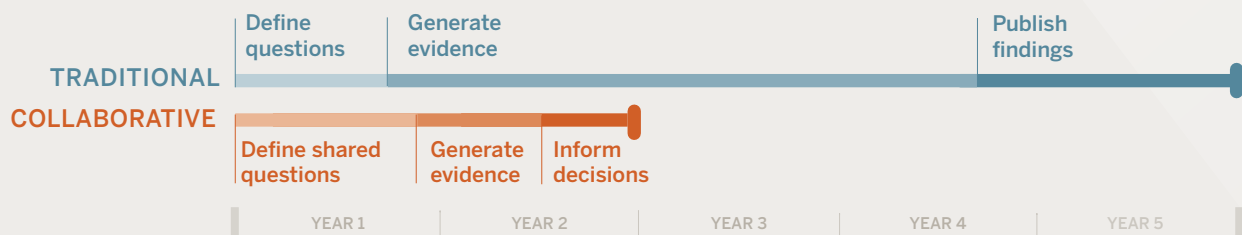

When communities co-design research, they co-create solutions that last. Collaborative research prioritizes relationships, mutual learning, and shared power. It recognizes that those closest to the issues often hold essential knowledge—and that research is most impactful when it leads to action.

Rapid and relevant

LONESTARP3's research-to-action model is collaborative from the outset which means more time is spent on the front end defining appropriate goals with our constituents. Once research is completed, it's rapidly disseminated. Traditional research often follows a longer, expert-driven model—a research team defines a problem, designs a study, collects and analyzes data, and publishes findings.

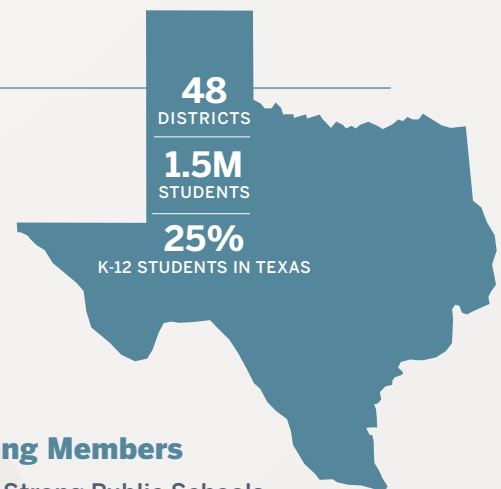
